## Assigning Attributes at a Mapping Level [by Faculty]

Attributes are a great tool to track important aspects of your curriculum and enable the generation of filtered reports based on specific topics, teaching methodology, assessment types, etc. You can assign attributes at the mapping level only if you would like to generate a progression-level report that shows you how the curriculum is progressing from a beginner to an advanced level.

Before you can assign attributes to any of the mappings, you'll need to complete the following Steps 1 and Step 2

## Steps:

1. Select Curriculum Mapping on your left-menu or dashboard



2. Select Curriculum Grid from the left ribbon.
